St. Paul's offers a range of outreach ministries, and you're always invited to take part:

Want to deliver food to Wake County residents in need? St. Paul's volunteers staff three Meals on Wheels routes on the third Wednesday of every month.

Want to serve the women at the Helen Wright Center? St. Paul's volunteers prepare breakfast on fifth Sundays.

Want to provide firewood to Wake County families in need? St. Paul's volunteers cut, split and deliver wood November through March with Warmth for Wake.

Want to raise money for local hunger-fighting agencies and international Church World Service efforts? St. Paul's volunteers annually take part in the October CROP Walk.

Want to help ensure the church's outreach ministry stays well funded? You can always contribute to the current fiscal year's outreach budget or to the Outreach Endowment Fund (the fund's principle is held intact, and quarterly interest payments go toward St. Paul's outreach work).
